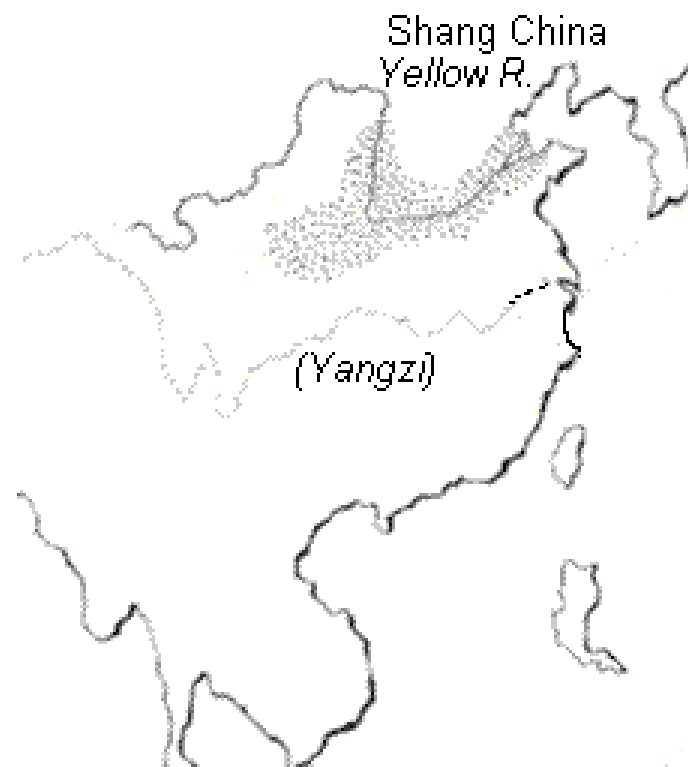
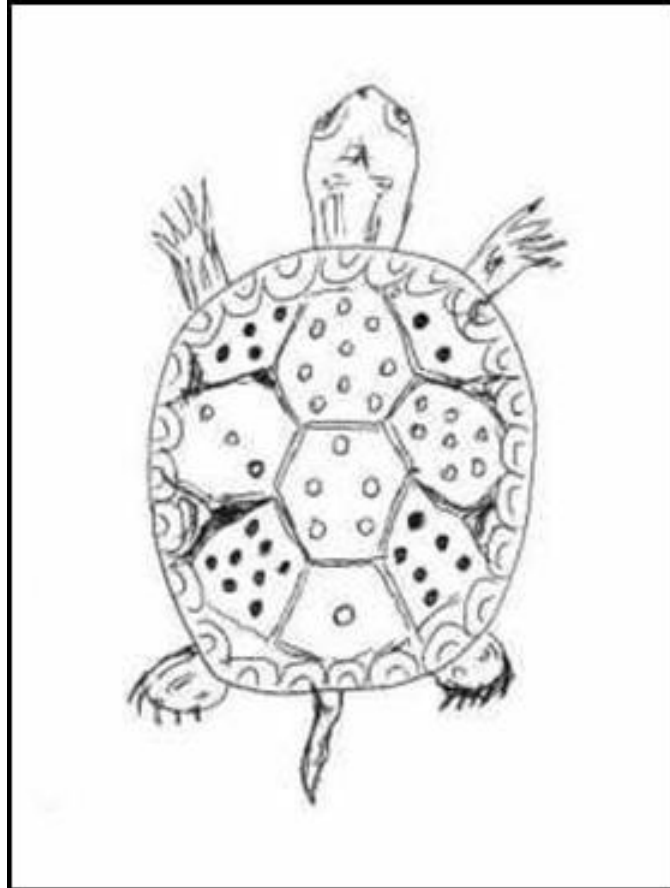


# The Magic Square



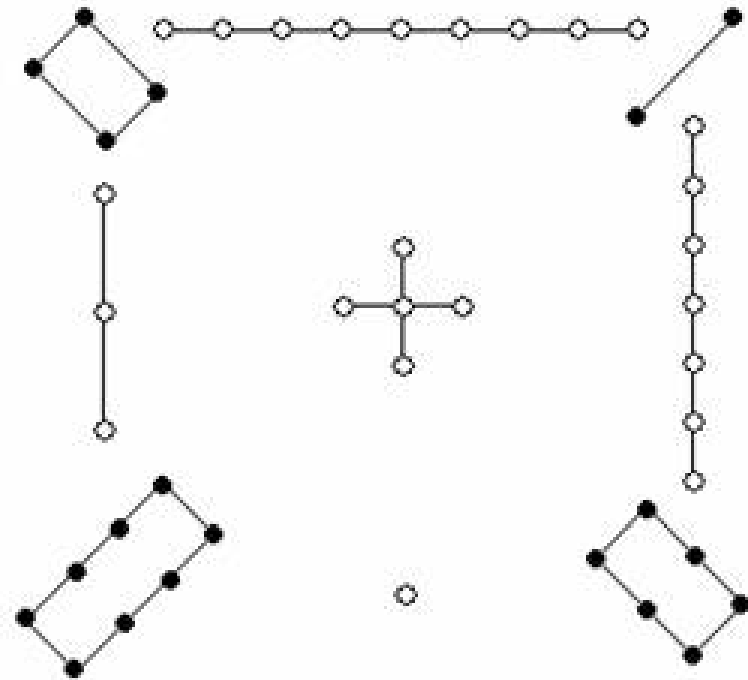
A long time ago, in ancient China, there was a huge flood of the River Lo.
